The Challenges Facing Higher Education Provision

“Higher education is a cultural and economic asset that fosters personal growth and societal progress. For vulnerable students, it offers economic security and a stable future.”

- UNESCO

Education costs are spiraling faster than inflation globally, student debt levels are at an all time high, higher education remains 'elitist' and exclusive, there are rising mental health concerns amongst University entrants, and graduate employment levels are dropping in a number of countries.

\$1.75 trillion student loan debt in the United States

268.28% increase in education prices, 1993-2023

5% of the world's 82-million refugees are enrolled in higher education.

35% of students screened positive for a mental health disorder

25% of all South Africans suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder.

4% of students that start grade 1 in South Africa end up with degrees:

including 70% of students barred from other institutions, achieving a 90% internship-to-permanent-job conversion rate.

An education institution

charging only £8.77 per month from students,

operating without government funding, and achieving 80% self-sustainability.

An education institution providing education valued at £77,000 to students,

while costing only £5,000

50% or less compared to other institutions, while offering up to 20 additional services.

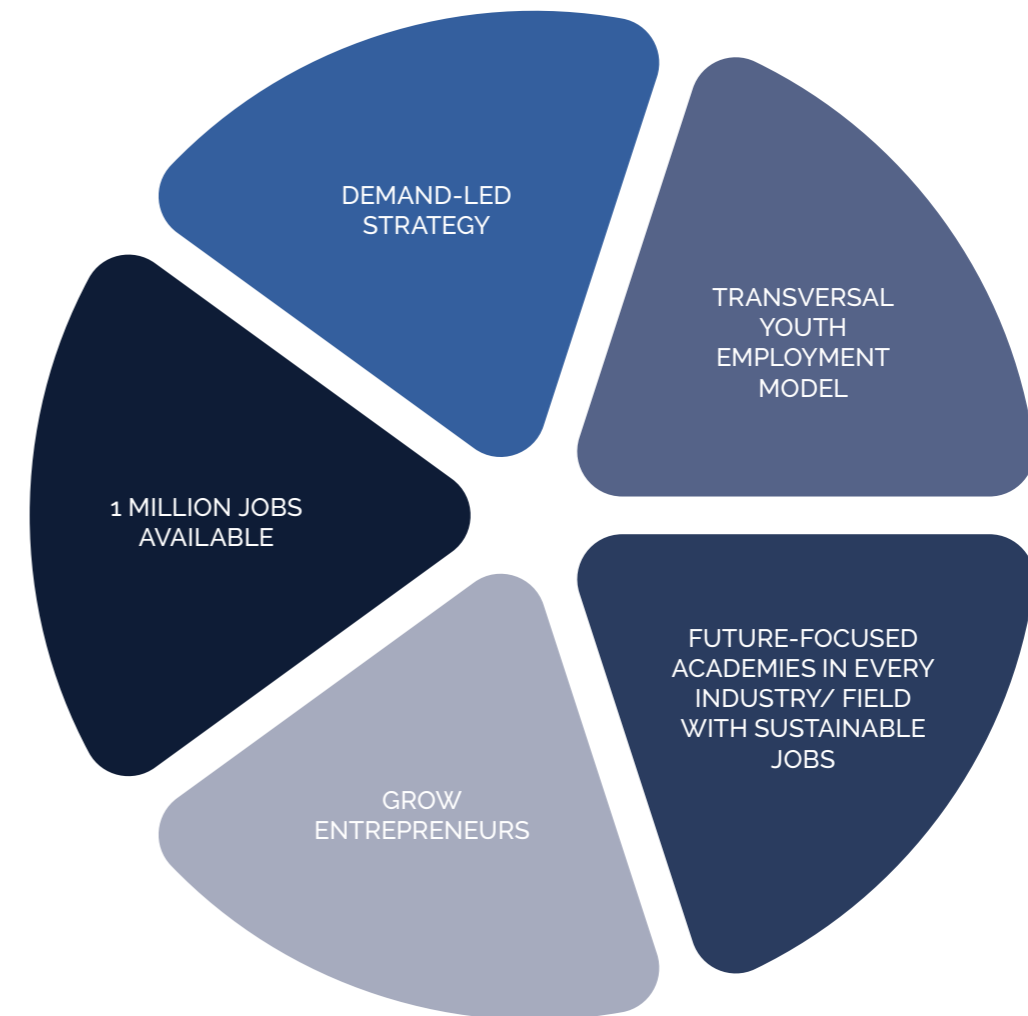

MII has led various system-change initiatives in South Africa. For instance, MII created and directs the E³ programme with the Department of Basic Education, promoting project-based learning in schools to enhance early problem-solving skills. MII also developed a mobile platform that connects nearly 70% of teachers and more than half of school principals in South Africa.
